Pairing Guide

Long press the **Home** and **Back** buttons at the same time until the red light flashes quickly; then release. That means the RCU has entered the pairing mode. Wait a few seconds without pressing any buttons until you see the pop-up message of pairing success

IR Power and Source learning instructions

1. Press the TV power key on the EVO PRO remote for 5 seconds, and the red light will flash to indicate that it is in the learning mode
2. Press any one of the infrared learning keys (Power or input/Source) and the red light will turn on indication that the key is learning.
3. At this time, press the button of the remote control you want to learn from transmit the key code. (The remotes must be facing each other. Placement should be about 1-2 inches apart)
4. After learning of the key codes is successful, the red light will turn off immediately.
5. If the process failed, the red light will turn off immediately.
6. Repeat steps 2-4 to learn all remaining IR key codes. (The EVO PRO remote learns Power and Input/Source only).
7. Once learning the key codes is complete, press the TV power key again. ensure that the red light is off and exit the learning mode. This will save key codes for Power and Input/Source that were just programmed
